- Be sure to include contact information of both nominator and nominee.

**Deadline:** Complete nominations must be received (not postmarked) in the Governor's Office of Minority Empowerment by close of business on **Wednesday, Dec. 4, 2013.**

**Note:** The winning recipient will be notified, and the award will be presented at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Annual Celebration on Wednesday, Jan. 16, 2014.
