Criteria:

Nominees should have demonstrated leadership and achievement to the principles of racial equality, interracial harmony, economic justice, participation in MLK holiday observances, and dedication to Dr. King's dream.

- All information should be typed and limited to one 8 ½ x 11" page. Do not send resumes, pictures or any additional paperwork.
- Only one entry per nominator will be accepted.
- Attach the nomination form to the one-page nominee qualification narrative.
- Be sure to include contact information of both nominator and nominee.

Deadline: Complete nominations must be received (not postmarked) in the Governor's Office of Minority Empowerment by close of business on **Thursday, Dec. 3, 2015**.

Note: The winning recipient will be notified, and the award will be presented at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Annual Celebration on Thursday, Jan. 14, 2016.
